



The Yamaha-ACT Scholarship Program

Sponsored by Yamaha Motor Corporation, U.S.A.,

The 2009 Yamaha-ACT Scholarship Program will provide two opportunities for ACT students based on merit, need, and quality of application materials:

1. **Two INDIVIDUAL STUDENT Scholarships** (total value approximately \$1,500) including (a) Travel Assistance to the 2009 Ag Media Summit and (b) a Career Development Gift Card Basket to be used at the student’s discretion. The Travel Assistance award (valued at approximately \$750) will cover costs to attend the Ag Media Summit in Fort Worth, Texas, August 1-5, 2009, including airfare, hotel accommodations, ground transportation and onsite expenses. The Career Development Gift Card Basket (valued at approximately \$750) will include gift cards designed to help the student in preparation for an expected career search (for example, this could include gift cards to a department store for business attire, office supply store for professional supplies, a gas card, etc.). Additionally, the top individual will be invited to serve as an intern for Yamaha during the 2009 Ag Media Summit (specific internships will be determined in part by the scholarship recipient’s major interest [i.e. print journalism, public relations, broadcasting, etc.]).
2. **One ACT CHAPTER Scholarship** (cash award of \$2,500) to be used by the chapter to assist its students with travel to the Ag Media Summit and additional professional development needs. Chapters should include a line-item budget for what the award will be used as part of its application.

APPLICATION PACKET TO INCLUDE (hard copy):

1. Application Form (Individual and Chapter applications)
2. Cover Letter to include as applicable (Individual and Chapter applications):
 - a. Individual cover letter should include relevant background information including collegiate courses, scholarships, work experience and personal activities. Chapter cover letter should include recent member activities and how they enhanced students' career development.
 - b. Professional goals and aspirations (Individual only)
 - c. Level of need and persuasive argument for why you should receive this scholarship (Individual and Chapter)
 - d. Any personal ATV use as related to farming and ranching (NOT required)
 - e. Chapter cover letter should provide a more general overview of the Chapter and a line item budget for how the scholarship will be used.
3. Copy of College Transcript (Individual application only)
4. Professional Resume (Individual application only)
5. To allow for an evaluation of individual student and Chapter agricultural communications skill level and area of interest, and to provide students with an opportunity to develop materials that can be used for his/her portfolio, please include a practical communications or marketing pieces pertaining to appropriate "ATV Safety Awareness" (refer to the attached ATV safety guidelines and recommendations). Individuals submit any ONE. Chapters submit any THREE. These may include:
 - a. Journalistic story / feature article
 - b. Public relations plan
 - c. Press release
 - d. Social media networking plan
 - e. Graphic design (for example: a print ad, brochure, web page, etc.)
 - f. Broadcast / Video story board (actual videos will not be accepted)
 - g. Photo essay

ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES AND RESTRICTIONS:

- **Deadline for Application:** Must be postmarked by Friday, March 27, 2009.
- Winners will be notified individually by no later than **May 1, 2009.**
- To be eligible for scholarships, individual and Chapter winners must attend the Ag Media Summit in Ft. Worth, Texas, August 1-5, 2009.
- Applicants must be 18-years-old or older and a full time student at the time of application and during the Ag Media Summit.
- Individual Student Scholarship Payout:
 - o Yamaha will book travel and accommodations for recipients to the Ag Media Summit.
 - o Yamaha will provide a \$250 prepaid credit card prior to the event to supplement recipient's onsite expenses.
 - o Yamaha will supply the Career Development Gift Card Basket prior to Ag Media Summit.
- ACT Chapter Scholarship Payout:
 - o Yamaha will provide a check in the amount of \$2,500 prior to Ag Media Summit.
