

There is no Entry Fee. Please use a separate registration form for each quilt. It is recommended that you keep a copy for your records. All quilts and stories by any age group are welcome. There will be a special mens quilt exhibit. Entries will not be judged. There will be a "People's Choice" award to be announced at noon on Saturday.

Quilts will be displayed on Friday, November 16, 2007 from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and Saturday, November 17, 2007 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. All quilts (except miniature) **MUST HAVE** a 4" finished sleeve attached to the back of the quilt. The top of the sleeve should be attached no higher than 95" from the bottom edge of the larger quilts.

You must notify Shirley no later than September 20, 2007 to have a sleeve made.
